This excursion is about Dybbøl and Sønderborg. At Dybbøl Banke, close to the city of Sønderborg, on a moraine hill with a magnificent view on the Flensburg Firth (in German: Flensburger Förde, in Danish: Flensborg Fjord), Danes and Germans fought each other in April 1864, with considerable effects until today. This excursion is about an old war and about new friendship between Denmark and Germany.

Universe (formerly [Danfoss Universe](#)) is a science park in Nordborg on the island of [Als](#) in southern Denmark. The park's vision is to create amazement around natural science, technology and entrepreneurship. Visitors learn about science through activities, experiences, and acquire knowledge about the world in which it occurs. Universe is noticeably different from other parks in the fact that learning is the linchpin for all the rides, experiences and amusements. The park motto is "The attraction park, where fun is a science".

After the visit to the park there will be time for lunch in the nearby city of Sønderborg.

Excursion 6: Arche Warder Animal Park, Brahmsee

Description:

Arche Warder is Europe's largest centre for rare and endangered domestic animals. More than 1,200 animals from over 80 different breeds can be found, including white Angler Saddleback pigs, Telemark cattle, Poitou-Donkey and Leinegans. In former times these breeds were common. Today, many of these breeds have less than 200 animals remaining worldwide. The idea is to protect these old breeds and to maintain their genetic diversity for future generations.

During the excursion the participants will be inspired by animal welfare aspects of farming. They will get to know old breeds that might be suitable for their scenario they worked with in Workshop No. 2.

NordArt is one of the largest exhibitions of contemporary art in Europe which takes place annually in the summer months. It takes place at the industrial monument Carlshütte, a former iron foundry operated by the first manufacturing company in the dukedoms of Schleswig and Holstein, active from 1827 to 1997, in the town of Büdelsdorf.

“The NordArt is an overall work of art in its own right and is designed as such each year. More than 200 international artists, selected by a jury, present a comprehensive panorama of contemporary art.”

NordArt is celebrating an anniversary this year: For the 20th time, the exhibition will be presenting paintings and sculptures, photographs and installations by 200 selected artists from all over the world.

This year's country focus is on the Czech Republic.
